Materials Needed

print needed worksheets, child's journal, pencil, crayons, scissors, 8-1/2 x 11 paper

Welcome Time: Free Play

Language Time

Worksheet: Journal Entry: Airplane

Math Time

Rocket Ship Blast-off: Have children crouch low on the floor, count to five, and say, "blast-off". Then jump into the air and fly like a rocket. Do it again, counting to a different number or try counting down. Try spinning like a helicopter, flying like an airplane, or driving a race car.

Worksheet: Counting Penguin Passengers

Music Time

Airplane Freeze: Play or sing music while the children fly around like an airplane. Stop the music and say, "freeze down low". They freeze until you say, "fly up high" and start the music again.

Art Time

Worksheet: Paper Airplanes

Science Time

Using the airplanes the children made, let them experiment flying them. Try some airplane races, or see how far they can fly their airplane, then mark where it lands.
