Directions

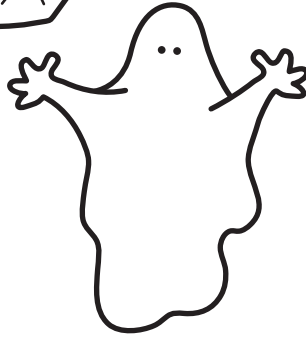
- Color and cut out pieces. Glue each onto the front of an envelope. Place a prize inside the envelope and close. For fun: make a valentine box to hold all the envelopes.
- Have a child choose a envelope and draw, sculpt or act out the clue. When someone guesses it, he gets the prize inside the envelope and it's the next child's turn.



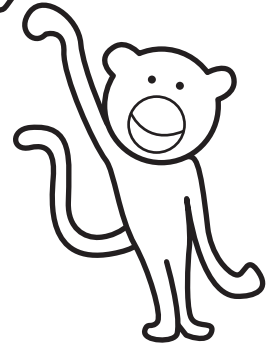
