Art Time

Sculpting Flowers: Preheat oven to 400 degrees. To make the dough, kneed 2 cups flour and 1/2 cup hot water, until it holds together. If it is too dry add more water, too sticky add more flour. Let each child sculpt a flower. Poke a hole in the top of the flower if they want a necklace, on both sides for a bracelet or poke a pencil in the bottom to make a pencil topper. Cook the flower in the oven from 2-5 minutes, depending on the size. Let it cool. Have the children paint or decorate their flowers. Tie a ribbon threw the top hole for the necklace or through the two side holes for a bracelet.
