

Groundhog Day Guessing Game

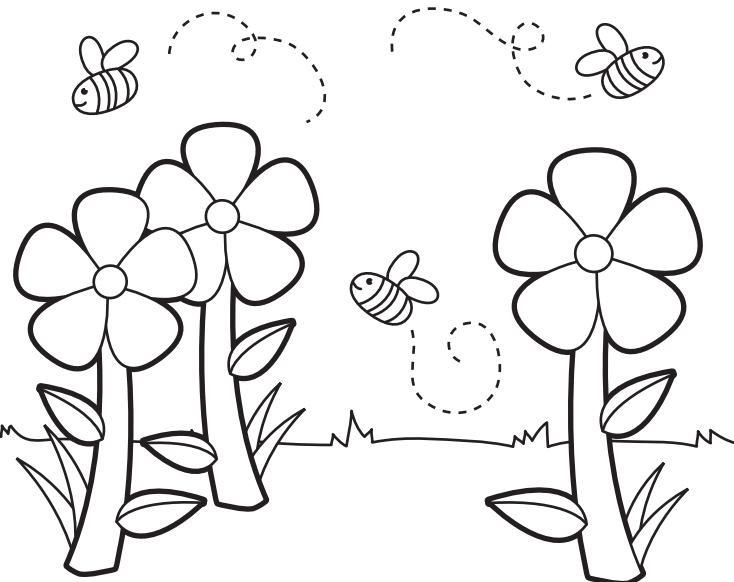
- RULES**
- One player uses the groundhog pieces, one uses the weather pieces.
 - The groundhog player chooses one piece and places it face down.
 - The weather player then tries to guess the matching weather piece and places it face up.
 - Flip over the pieces and if the pieces match, the weather player gets a Phil award piece.
 - If the pieces don't match, the groundhog player gets a Phil award piece.
 - The game ends when all the Phil award pieces are gone.
 - The player with the most Phil award pieces wins.

The name of the Groundhog used during the celebration.
