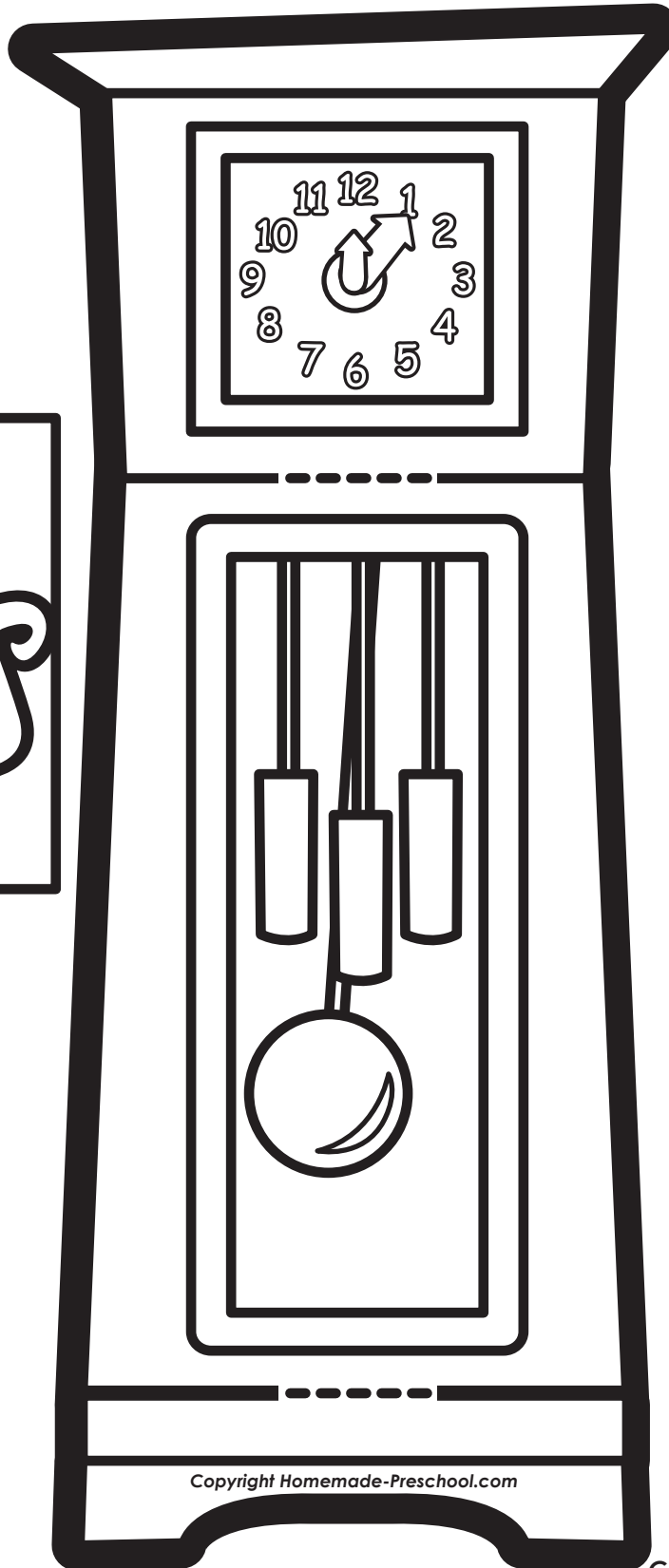
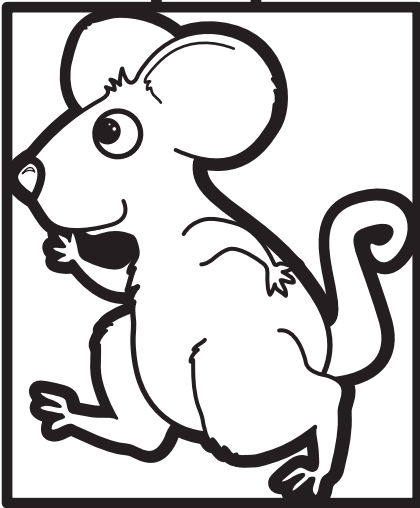


Hickory, Dickory, Dock
