Materials Needed

Language Time

Worksheet: Build-a-Book Seasons (Have the children take turns reading their books)

Autumn Leaves are Falling Down: Have two children hold hands to form a bridge and sing the words to the tune of "London Bridge is Falling Down." Have the other children walk under the bridge as they sing the first verse. When they sing, "on the ground," the two children trap the one walking through. They sing the next verse, while swaying their prisoner back and forth, like they're raking leaves. They let the prisoner go and do it again.
