 **ACTIVITY: Popcorn Popping Catchers**

Show the children the popcorn kernels and explain that the Indians taught the pilgrims how to grow corn by planting kernels in the ground. Then explain that kernels are also used to make popcorn. Place some oil in the bottom of a pan and pour the kernels in, put the lid on. Turn the stove onto medium heat. Explain that the heat will make the kernels get so hot inside that they pop open. When it is finished, give each child a plastic cup and toss the popcorn and have the children try to catch it in their cups.
