 **WORKSHEET:** **Kooky Carnival Tickets** (Print out enough tickets for each child to have seven. Give each child a ticket after each worksheet and activity.)

 **ACTIVITY:** **Show and Tell**

Welcome all the children to a special preschool carnival. Tell them that they will have lots of fun, play games and earn tickets that they can turn in for a prize at the end. Explain that at a carnival you can win prizes, like stuffed animals. Then have each child take a turn showing their stuffed animal.

 **WORKSHEET:** **ABC Carnival Duck Pond**

 **ACTIVITY:** **Balloon Bop Activity**

Gather all the children in a group and explain that they are going to try to keep the balloon up for ten bops. Then have the children bop the balloon and count each time they do. When they do ten bops in a row, give them their tickets.

 **ACTIVITY:** **Limbo**

Turn on some fun music and line the children up. Hold a pole horizontally and have each child walk under it, then lower the pole. See how low they can go.
