Martin Luther King Jr.

BORN: He was born on January 15, 1929, in Atlanta, Georgia.

LEADER: He was a Baptist minister and an important leader in the American Civil Rights movement. He led many events and believed in peaceful protests, not violence.

"I HAVE A DREAM": In March 1963, during the March on Washington, he gave one of the greatest and most influential speeches in American history.

NOBEL PEACE PRIZE: He was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1964.

DIED: He was killed on April 4th, 1968, in Memphis, Tennessee, at the age of 39.

HOLIDAY: Martin Luther King Jr. Day became an official holiday in 1983.

MEMORIAL: A memorial was made for him in Washington, D.C., in 2011.
