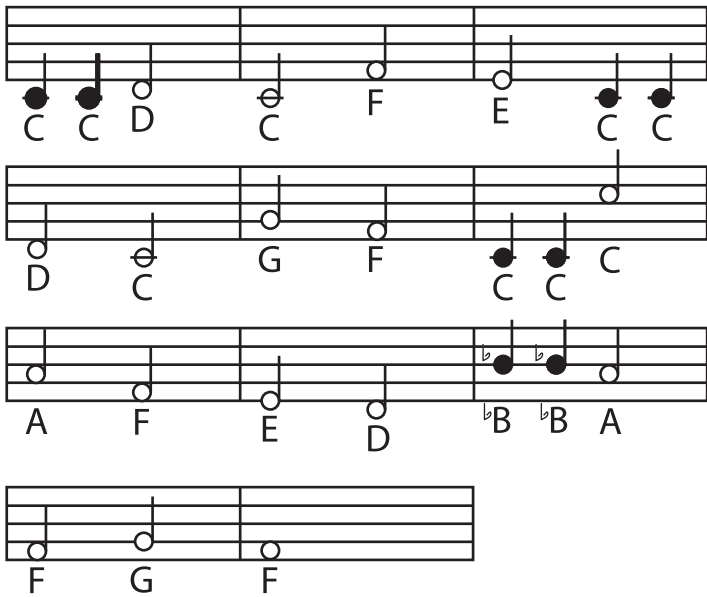
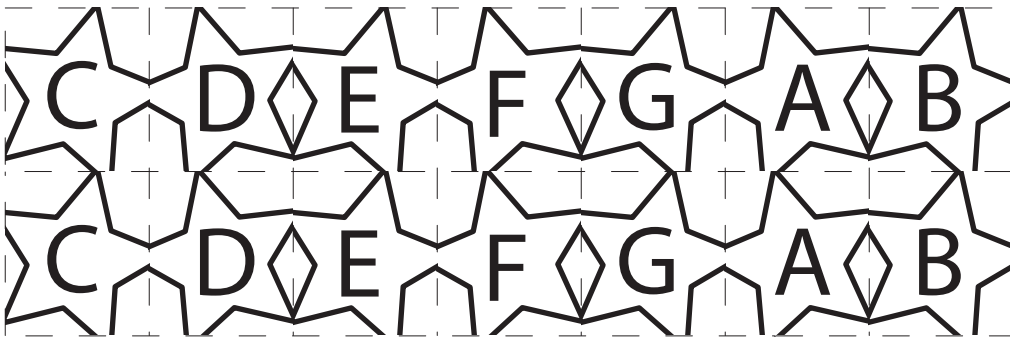


Piano Lesson: Notes

Directions

- Color and cut out the pieces. Place one set of the letter pieces on the piano keys and put the others in a pile.
- Show your child the picture of the book and ask what makes up the words in the books. Then show your child the picture of the music and explain that music is made up of notes. Notes are like letters and they show you which keys to play on the piano.
- Give your child the pile of notes and have him match them to the keys on the piano.
- Let your child play with the keys and make up his own songs.



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
