Materials Needed

Popsicle Licking Race: While still outside, give each child a popsicle and tell them it's a race to see how fast they can get to the stick by licking.

Music Time

Beach Ball Bullfrog: Have the children stand in a circle. While singing "Down by the Banks," pass the beach ball around. When you sing, "kerplop" have the child holding the ball bounce it and the child that catches it gets start the next round.

Down by the banks of the hanky panky
Where the bullfrogs jump from bank to banky
Saying eep ipe ope oop
One jumps in and goes Kerplop!

Art Time

Bubble Poppers: Give each child a piece of construction paper. Blow bubbles and have them catch them on the paper and see what fun designs they can make.

Worksheet: My Beach Vacation (Get a bowl of lemon juice and some q-tips, then preheat the oven to 350 degrees. Tell your child they get to color with sunshine. Let them color, then put their picture in the oven for 2 minutes. Let them see what they colored.)
